David Miller makes a motion to accept the amended calendar. Brad Willis seconds it. Passed Unanimously.

Mike Zeggelaar makes a motion that Regina-Veronicka Kalaydina can use \$1000 of travel funds which she earned as the 2013 AB Women's champion, for any major event until the end of 2014, due to the fact that no Canadian Women's Championship was held in 2013. Seconded by: Armine Arzumanyan.

Passed Unanimously.

Terry Seehagen makes a motion to award Diwen ACA Jr Ambassador for 2013 due to the fact that one of the current ambassadors is out of the province. Brad Willis seconds. 4 in favour David Miller and Hubert Shi abstain.

Brad Willis makes a motion to adjourn the meeting. Hubert Shi seconds. Passed Unanimously.
