Registration Process

Pre-register online by going to www.albertachess.org/2016ACC.php and filling out a registration form. Payment will be made on site on the day of the tournament. Pre-registered players must come by 10:45 am or they won't be paired in round 1.

Entry Fee

\$35 if registered online by 8pm, Friday, April 8, \$40 afterwards and on-site. The entry fee includes light lunch.

Tournament Schedule

On-Site Registration: 10:15 am – 10:45 am

Opening Ceremony: 10:50 am – 11 am

Rounds 1 and 2: 11 am – 1 pm

Lunch: 1 pm – 2 pm

Rounds 3 and 4: 2 pm – 4 pm or ASAP

Tie-Breaks (if necessary) and Awards: ASAP after the last round

Time control: Game in 20 minutes with a 5-second increment per move.

Byes: Up to two half point byes in rounds 1-3 are allowed if requested before start of round 1.

First/Second/Third: Trophies.

Section winners will represent team Alberta at the 2016 Canadian Chess Challenge.
